COLLEGE IN THE HIGH SCHOOL

PROGRAM

Through a partnership with Norman Public Schools and the University of Oklahoma, the College in the High School program will bring OU courses, taught by OU professors, to Norman High and Norman North next Fall and Spring.

COURSES

Introduction to Women's and Gender Studies- Western Culture Credit

3 hours of college credit

Norman High: Fall 2017 at 10 AM on MWF

Norman North: Spring 2017 at 10 AM on MWF

Examines women's issues and movements in the United States and globally, with a focus on the pervasive role of gender in people's lives and on the ways it is used to create privilege for some and oppress others. Through readings, films, class discussions, and guest speakers, this course is designed to challenge traditional, normative notions about gender and sexuality, which are inextricably entwined. Also explores ways other markers of difference, such as disability, race, and religion, intersect with gender identity and sexual identity.

Introduction to Film and Media Studies- Artistic Form: 3 hours of college credit

Norman High: Spring 2017 at 10 AM on MWF

Norman North: Fall 2017 at 10 AM on MWF

An examination of the history, role, impact, nature and delivery systems of film and media in the United States and the international community.

*Must watch films at OU from 4:30 – 6:45 PM on Wednesdays in Dale Hall 200

College Algebra- Math Credit (Seniors only) 3 hours of college credit

Norman Public Schools: Full year course at 11 AM on MWF

This is a full year course. Student must be able to take it for the entire year. Review of basic algebraic skills such as multiplying and factoring polynomials, rational expressions, linear equations and inequalities, exponents and radicals, absolute values. Other topics include the concept, notation, and algebra of functions, functions of linear, polynomial, rational, exponential, and logarithmic type, systems of equations.

*Students must enroll in the full year College Algebra course

ELIGIBILITY

Spots for these courses are limited. It is first come, first serve. Eligibility requirements are for the **Women and Gender Studies/Film and Media Studies courses**.
