

**Please read the following before completing the attached Driver Education application.**

*Rules and regulations governing student eligibility are as follows:*

### **STUDENT ELIGIBILITY**

Students who enroll in Driver and Traffic Safety Education in any public school of this state must show evidence that they are physically and mentally capable of receiving instruction and may profit from the course.

Any student receiving instruction in Driver and Traffic Safety Education, under the provisions of the law, shall be:

at least fifteen (15) years of age and a secondary school student.

The student shall meet the requirements while regularly enrolled and certified by the instructor as a student taking a prescribed course of secondary school driver education, to operate a motor vehicle while accompanied by, and receiving instruction from said instructor who is actually occupying a seat beside the driver.

### **Attendance**

The Driver Education program requires 30 hours of classroom and 6 hours of behind the wheel instruction. This must be completed in the 19 day session, therefore; **ATTENDANCE** is mandatory. Students are allowed to miss 1 day for an emergency (doctor, funeral, etc.). Makeups for that absence must be made the following day or you will be dropped from the program. There are no excused or unexcused absences (including doctors, funerals, etc.). Any time missed must be cleared with the student's instructor and the Administrator. **Please do not sign up if this schedule will not fit your student's summer activities (vacation, camps, other activities, etc.). No special arrangements will be made.**

### **Tardy Policy**

It is important for students to arrive on time for each class period. A student will be considered tardy to class if he/she is not in the classroom when the bell rings for class to begin.

### **Behavior Expectations**

Policies in the Norman Public Schools handbook will be followed.

### **Dress Code**

Dress code will be same as during regular school year.
