Attendance Policy

**A student must be in attendance 90% of the
semester.** Each semester is 19 days in length and
consists of 4 class periods per day, for a total of
76 class periods of instruction. To receive credit
in a course, a student may miss **no more** than 8
class periods (2 full days) - **including vacation.**
Each full day missed is like being absent for a full
week of school. Make-up work will be accepted
for excused absences. It is up to the discretion of
individual teachers to determine when make-up
work is due.

Tardy Policy

It is important for students to arrive on time for
each class period. A student will be considered
tardy to class if he/she is not in the classroom
when the bell rings for class to begin. Detention
may be assigned for tardies.
